## Proposed Agenda:

- I. Treasurer's Report
  - a. Review of Financials
    - 1. Spreadsheet: Reviewed by all members prior to meeting; no concerns raised
      - 2. NTTC: obtained this quarter
  - b. Update on all Fundraisers for Quarter: Between Facebook fundraisers, End-of-Year Giving Campaign and private donations, raised \$1576.62 this quarter.
  - c. Goal: Replacing \$5000 personal funding from Shelbra: Approved; discussed moving bank account to Nusenda where minimum balance is \$1500 less than current account, allowing Shelbra to take the difference; no action taken at this time; will discuss again at next meeting.
- II. Mission
  - a. Inaugural Funding Cycle
    - 1. Scholarship Review: Reviewed summaries of 4 applications from Saranam and agreed to fund all fully, choosing to exceed the previously set limit of \$1000. Total cash funding was \$4041.75 with 2 laptops with computer bags awarded.
    - 2. Process Feedback: Shelbra has spoken with other agencies to determine what factors contributed to only one agency submitting applications; followed up with Barrett Foundation, Valencia Shelter Services, Haven House, New Day Shelter and Crossroads. Feedback received was that the application was user-friendly but the respective agencies felt that they didn't have their processes in place to engage. Follow-up meetings with the organizations have been scheduled in the first quarter of 2024. Hoping to reopen application process in Summer 2024.

## b. Programming

- 1. Story Repository: have decided not do a repository of survivors stories but to create a testimony page
- 2. Expanding to include recipients in the community: Discussed expanding funding to include programs serving DV survivors with workforce development directly. In talks with Family Advocacy Center around their Coding Bootcamp program.
- c. Rebranding: Paused for now.

- d. Social Media Management: Megan Cohen has volunteered marketing services to assist with Social Media and Newsletter management. Will be collaborating and developing this part of Foundation in the next quarter
- e. Newsletter: Plan is to work with Megan Cohen around creation and launch of a newletter in time for anniversary of incorporation, 1/27/24.
- f. Voluntime: asked all members to log their hours so they can be counted in year-end totals.
  - III. Board of Directors
    - a. Follow-Up Report on Board Requirements: Discussed results of individual polling around board requirements without agreement; this will be area of focus in 2024; tabled until next meeting.
  - IV. Fundraising

    - 1. Mother's Day Auction: scheduled to begin 4/14; members asked to begin soliciting items. Discussed looking into online platforms that can host a hybrid event. Also discussed finding venues where we might hold an in-person finale.
